



GENERAL CONDITIONS – ACADEMY AST

By signing the registration form, the student accepts the terms and conditions that are set out below.

1. SPANISH COURSE

- 1.1 Spanish courses will be taught in individual programs (15 days, 4 weeks and 10 months).
- 1.2 The institution where the courses are taught will be the *Escuela de Idiomas Carlos V*.
- 1.3 The teachers of the Spanish classes will be native speakers of Spanish.
- 1.4 Students will be organized by levels and the final schedules will be communicated prior to the beginning of the course. The school reserves the possibility of modifying the schedules according to organizational needs.

1.5 Includes:

- Material for the Spanish course (notebooks, pens and other necessary materials)
- Spanish level test simulations.
- Student guide, information about the school and the city.
- Participation in the general and free activities of the academy.
- Academy Wi-Fi.
- Certificate of attendance to the course (without official validity).
- Student attention service 8.00 h. at 10:00 p.m. Monday to Friday.

1.6 Does not include:

- Access to specific activities and that will be established at a cost
- Official level exam fees
- Anything that is not expressly included in the registration or in the general conditions.

2. ENROLLMENT

2.1 The particular conditions of each program in terms of duration, sessions, start and end dates, contracted services and as well as the levels and specific associated activities will be expressed in the budget accepted by the student and in the registration.

2.2 Students will have a minimum age of 14 years.

3. PRICES

3.1 The price of the course generally includes:

- The transfer to the airport or the train station.
- Sports equipment (t-shirts, tracksuit, pants...)
- Visit to sports clubs (Valid for the summer and 10-month program)



- 1 daily laundry service (sportswear only)
- Injury insurance.
- Visit of professional players (Valid for the summer program and 10 months)
- Full board at the academy residence on the days contracted in the selected program.
- 20 weekly hours of soccer.
- Friendly matches against local clubs.

3.2 The price of the course does NOT generally include:

- The trip itself (plane, train...)
- Travel insurance.

4. ACCOMMODATION

4.1 The time of arrival and departure must be communicated one week in advance to facilitate logistics management with the residence. Sunday being the official day of entry from 5:00 p.m. and departure before 12:00 h.

4.2 The residence where the students stay will be [Nodis Sevilla Residence](#).

4.3 Any change of accommodation requested by the student without justified cause will entail a management cost that the student will bear.

4.4 Once the stay in the accommodation has begun, it can only be abandoned by communicating it in writing one week in advance, unless it is for reasons of force majeure (serious medical, family or personal reasons).

4.5 The student will accept all the rules indicated by the [Nodis Sevilla residence](#).

4.6 In the event that the student is expelled by the residence, it will be the student who will bear the costs of a new establishment for their accommodation.

4.7 The residence includes full board of breakfast, lunch and dinner.

5. TRANSPORT

5.1 The transfer to the airport or the train station is included in the price.

5.2 The time of arrival and departure must be communicated one week in advance to facilitate the logistics management of transport.

5.3 The academy will indicate to the student the place and time of meeting.

5.4 Any change that may occur must be communicated to the telephone number indicated in the Academy's information and always sufficiently in advance so that the Academy can reorganize the collection. Any extra charge that these changes entail must be borne by the student.

5.5 If the student does not show up within 60 minutes of the agreed time and location, the service will be cancelled, but the student will still have to pay for the service.



6. RESERVATION AND REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

- 6.1 The student must send the "[Academy Soccer AST- Application](#)" form duly completed and the academy will confirm their participation by email, attaching a budget with the conditions and the total amount of the program.
- 6.2 The student must pay the entire program and associated services.
- 6.3 Each program has an associated guarantee that is detailed in the budget.
- 6.4 **IMPORTANT:** as long as the student's payment is not received, his place will not be blocked and confirmed.
- 6.5 In all payments made by the student must indicate her name and send proof of payment to the academy as far as possible. Bank commissions will always be borne by the student.

7. CANCELLATIONS

- 7.1 All cancellations must be communicated in writing by email to the address info@academyast.com for their validity.
- 7.2 For cancellations made one month in advance, the academy will return the amount of the course minus the amount of the deposit (amount associated in the budget).
- 7.3 For those carried out less than a month in advance, the academy will not refund any amount, but the student may use it to carry out the program with similar characteristics and as long as there is availability.
- 7.4 Once the program has started, if the student had to leave it for reasons beyond the academy's control, no amount will be returned.
- 7.5 The academy may cancel the group as long as there is no confirmed place. When only one or two people participate in the group, the training sessions can be cut in half.
- 7.6 In the event of force majeure or a pandemic, the student will have the right to cancel their participation in the program and receive all amounts paid to date.

8. LANGUAGE SCHOOL GROUPS

- 8.1 Before arriving at the school, the student will take a level test that will allow the school to assign them a group based on their level and interest.
- 8.2 When the student arrives at the school, a new level test will be carried out, on this personal occasion, to confirm the level of languages and to incorporate the student into the group that finally corresponds to them based on their level.

9. STUDENT INSURANCE

- 9.1 The academy has general civil liability and injury insurance for all students and for those incidents that may occur within the facilities, incidents that occur outside or on the way to them will not be covered.
- 9.2 The student can hire a private travel policy to cover the rest of incidents that may occur. The academy recommends taking out medical care insurance, especially for those who do not belong to the European Union.



10. TRAINING

10.1 All players will be evaluated in the first training session to find out first-hand the player's football level.

11. CONDITIONS OF THE ACADEMY

11.1 The academy has a claims book in accordance with official regulations.

11.2 On national or local holidays (Seville) there will be no classes or training.

11.3 Violence or disrespect to other colleagues or Academy staff may force the student to leave the program.

11.4 The student authorizes the academy so that those graphic images or videos, in any format, that the academy can capture, are used to inform and/or publicize its activity. These may be reproduced in paper format, on the academy's websites, social networks, as well as in publications owned by the academy. The treatment of said material will always be from the respect and in accordance with Organic Law 3/2018, of December 5, 2018, Protection of Personal Data and Guarantee of Digital Rights (LOPD GDD), being able to exercise the rights of access, rectification, cancellation and opposition in relation to your personal data submitted to these treatments, through the email info@academyast.com. The images will not be used for any purpose other than that expressed.

11.5 These general conditions must be signed before the student joins the program.
